PHASE I (2011)

- Ten refurbished computers
- Internet service by Claro
- Install electrical system, wiring and lighting
- Purchase scanner/printer, modem, 10 desks and chairs, 4 terminals
- Security: alarm system

PHASE II (2012)

- 10 extra computers, furniture
- Security: camera system

PHASE III (2013)

- General maintenance, furniture, playground, library and kitchen.

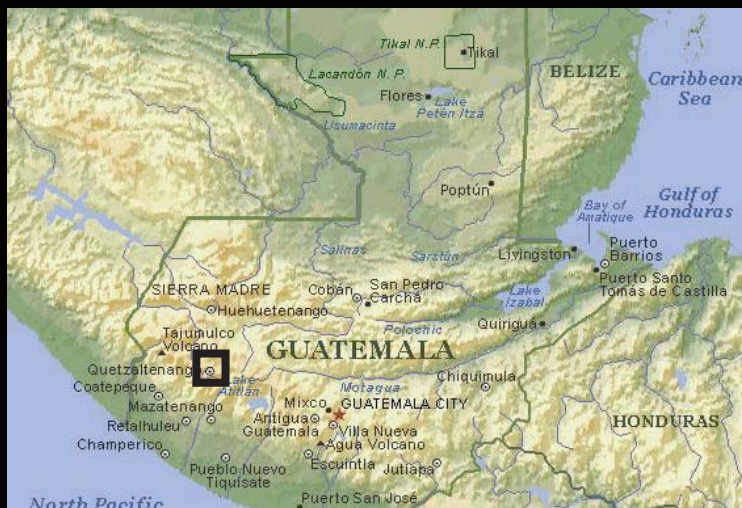
