Description

- Grant scholarships to children from coffee farmers in nine cooperatives.
- Cecocafen scholarship program has given access to education to many young boys and girls.
- In return Cecocafen asks scholarship students to get involved in their cooperatives.
- Students receive grants of \$15.72 per month (Secondary education) to \$31.45 per month (College education).
