The target group consists of a small group of farmers and families, depending directly on their work in the coffee plantations.

Since these plantations are located in remote areas, many will benefit from our water filters.



SUSTAINABLE ACHIEVEMENTS

SOCIAL EMPOWERMENT

By reducing the consumption of unclean or hazardous water, the project aims at eliminating contamination: a benefit for public health. This automatically affects positively the daily wellbeing and the working lives of the communities. Also children will benefit from these water filters.

The project also provides education; training sessions are implemented about safe water drinking and healthy practices to reduce generic diseases.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT

By helping families to be conscious about water, the ecologic aspect is touched since they are made conscious about preserving water. Less pressure on natural resources preserves the planet.

ECONOMIC RELEVANCE
