

PURPOSE

- Strengthen Perene cooperative in sustainable production, human resource capacities, promotion of agroforestry systems, and food safety.
- "Perene" cooperative is sufficiently established to enable its members to conduct their coffee production and revenue diversification activities in a sustainable, economic, social and environment-friendly fashion.

TARGET GROUP

Quantitative

- 300 families of smallholder coffee producers (average, 6.5 people per household)
- Total beneficiaries: 1,950 people

Qualitative

- Cooperative members
- Age group: 30 - 50
- Men: 240 members; Women: 60 members
- Education:
 - 80% to Elementary education
 - 20% to Secondary education
